





## Critical infrastructure concerns

### 90% of manufactured goods travel by ship International Maritime Organisation

Sealift, either through Defence-owned shipping or *hired commercial shipping*, is the most cost-effective means and only real practicable method of deploying at scale to even land locked countries. UK Department of Defence JDP0-10
